The Need for a Spanish Version Competency to Proceed Assessment Measure Nelly Christy'Ann Ore, 2011 Forensic psychology arose due to courts having concerns about mental health issues. Specifically, the court may request competency to proceed evaluations. Regarding competency, there is one important case law to consider that identifies different criteria and specific questions to follow depending on the state and its laws (*Dusky v. United States*, 1960). Competency has been described as a construct that is not generally observable, yet the presence of it will impact the behavior of an individual, which in turn will appear observable (Grisso, 1986). Statistics provide information suggesting that there are a number of individuals involved in the legal system that are only Spanish speaking. Moreover, there are many individuals that are only Spanish speaking that have been found incompetent to proceed. As such, there is a need to consider what is being done to inform the courts with respect to competency to proceed with Spanish speaking individuals. There is also a need to consider the use of assessments that have been developed specifically for competency to proceed and if there are any standardized assessment measures for Spanish speakers. Research has indicated assessment of competency to proceed is further complicated for the forensic examiner when the defendant is not fluent in English. Data indicates this is due to standard assessments being inadequate for evaluating Hispanic immigrants (Johnson & Torres, 1992). As a result of these problems, the opinions of psychologists assessing individuals on the basis of translation of assessments were weakened

because the reliability of the assessments they utilized was questioned. The findings concluded that the development of an assessment measure in Spanish could prevent future appeals that may result in the need for the courts to spend more money in order to provide a new competency to proceed evaluation. The development of a competency to proceed assessment measure will result in minimization of bias, subjectivity, errors in translation, and will reduce the number of opinions that may be weakened due to the use of a non-standardized measure. This opens a door for further studies to be conducted in order to develop a Spanish competency to proceed assessment measure, as well as standardize it for the Spanish speaking population.
