Wider den Wiener Größenwahn Theodor Lamar, 2023-01-06 Die Welt sah düster aus für jene Niedersachsen, die sich im August 1841 auf Helgoland einfanden. Vier Jahre zuvor war ihr Königreich Hannover aus dem Kreis der Verfassungsstaaten ausgetreten und ins Lager des Wiener Absolutismus gewechselt, Oppositionelle waren des Landes verwiesen worden.
